



The CalWORKs Program is a component of the County's Welfare to Work Program. The AVDVC CalWORKs Program is for CalWORKs recipients in our community who are experiencing domestic violence. The program has grown to such large numbers that we offer individual, group and AMAC (Adults Molested as Children) therapy five days a week. We offer both English and Spanish classes. We provide services to men, women, gays, lesbians, and transgender victims.

The classes are divided into three different levels:

Level 1: The participants learn the basics of domestic violence such as:

- What is domestic violence?
- Who are the victims?
- Who are the abusers?
- Red Flags
- Safety Planning

Level 2: The clients learn to work on themselves and put the principles they've learned in Level 1 in to practice.

Level 3: Is a therapeutic group taught by a therapist.

We provide a safe child care program for the children while the parent is in group.

Our goal is to help victims of domestic violence develop the resources they need to live a safe and fulfilling life free of violence.
