



The Homeless Solutions Access Center was created due to a community-wide need to assist individuals and families that are homeless for a wide variety of reasons.

This program was the valley's first Access Center, which is an entryway to services for all homeless people. Serving individuals and families, our multi team agency collaboration with other agencies in the community helps with basic needs and links them to the services they need to put a permanent end to their homelessness.

With partners on site and in the community, the center tailors its help to meet mental health, health, substance abuse recovery, domestic violence, employment assistance, housing assistance, living skills and HIV/AIDS service needs.

Services offered at our drop-in center meets immediate needs such as:

- Showers
- Laundry
- Emergency Transportation
- Food and clothing
- Placement in emergency and transitional housing



Our long-term assistance in finding housing, learning living skills, and receiving health and mental health treatment is the key to helping individuals move to safety and stability off the streets.
