



Oasis House is a 2-year transitional housing program with one (1) year case management follow up.

Residents applying for or being referred to the Oasis House will be required to undergo an evaluation process. The evaluation process may last up to thirty (30) days. The resident must participate in all shelter programs during this process.

Services offered to the residents are:

- Peer Counseling
- Case Management
- Therapeutic assessments, groups and individuals counseling
- Domestic Violence Education Groups
- Living Skills
- Job Development
- Parenting Skills
- Court Accompaniment
- Transportation
- Legal Assistance
- Homework Club
- Budgeting
- Transportation
- Assistance in Securing Permanent Housing
- Assistance in Applying for Financial Aid



Qualified Staff meet with the residents on a regular basis to assist them in areas of basic family needs and to prepare them for living on their own. Needs may vary depending on situations that may arise while they are in the program.
